**SECOND NOTICE OF CHANGE TO TEXT AS ORIGINALLY PROPOSED**  
***Inmate Recruiting and Hiring Process***

The amendments to text of the California Code of Regulations (CCR) that concern CALPIA Inmate Recruiting and Hiring Processes is provided as follows:

**Original Proposed Regulations**

single underline indicates original added or amended text  
single strikeout indicates original deleted text

**First 15-day Notice Changes**

double underline indicates added or amended changed text to original proposed language  
double strikeout indicates deleted text to original proposed language

**Second 15-day Notice Changes**

bold double underline indicates added or amended changed text to original proposed language  
bold double strikeout indicates deleted text to original proposed language

These revisions are being made to renumber regulations and reinstate regulatory language. Also included in this Second Notice of Change is a Supplemental to the Initial Statement of Reasons. This supplemental is included to further explain the original proposed text.

These changes to original proposed text are being made available for public comment from March 2, 2015 through March 18, 2015.

**REVISIONS TO REGULATION TEXT:**

New Subsection 8004(b)(3)(B):

- The original language regarding “an institutional Work Supervisor's Report, CDC 101 (1/92), which is incorporated by reference” in subsection 8004.3(c) was deleted in the original proposed text. In the second set of changes to the proposed text, the original language regarding “an institutional Work Supervisor's Report, CDC 101 (1/92)” is reinstated and moved to new subsection 8004(b)(3)(B). The language moved to new subsection 8004(b)(3)(B) did not create any substantial changes because moving original regulatory language does not alter its meaning.

Subsection 8004.2(f)(3) from original regulatory language is renumbered to New Subsection 8004.2(f)(4).

Subsection 8004.3(c) was amended to:

1. Reinstating and moving original language “an institutional Work Supervisor's Report, CDC 101 (1/92), which is incorporated by reference” to new subsection 8004(b)(3)(B). During the first set of changes to the regulatory text, the original language was deleted. In the second set of changes, the original language regarding “an institutional Work Supervisor's Report, CDC 101 (1/92)” is reinstated in new subsection 8004(b)(3)(B) with its original content.
2. Reinstating and moving the following original language from subsection 8004.3(b) to Subsection 8004.3(c):

‘Any inmate found to be in violation of Section 3016 shall be immediately removed from the CALPIA work/training program, and may be subject to the provisions of Section 3315, Serious Rule Violations.’

In the original proposed text, the original language mentioned above in quotes was omitted from subsection 8004.3(b). This language is being reinstated and moved to subsection 8004.3(c). Moving/Reinstating the language did not create any substantial changes because moving/reinstating original regulatory language does not alter its meaning.
