

FINAL STATEMENT OF REASONS

OAL File Number 2015-0928-01 is incorporated by reference in its entirety. The Initial Statement of Reasons within OAL File Number 2015-0928-01 is also incorporated by reference.

UPDATE OF INITIAL STATEMENT OF REASONS

OAL File Number 2015-0928-01, concerning CALPIA inmate recruitment and hiring processes, was published on October 9, 2015 and submitted for OAL's final review on January 22, 2016.

At OAL's request, CALPIA withdrew its rulemaking file to make minor revisions to the Initial Statement of Reasons. OAL File Number 2015-0928-01 was officially withdrawn on March 2, 2016.

CALPIA created a Supplemental to the Initial Statement of Reasons based on OAL's request. The Supplemental was placed on a 15 Day Notice of Change from March 8 through March 23, 2016. No comments were received.

LOCAL MANDATE:

The proposed regulations do not impose any mandate on local agencies or school districts.

ALTERNATIVES THE WOULD LESSEN ADVERSE ECONOMIC IMPACT ON SMALL BUSINESS:

No alternatives were proposed to CALPIA or Prison Industry Board that would lessen any adverse economic impact on small business.

ALTERNATIVES DETERMINATION:

CALPIA has determined that no alternative it considered or that was otherwise identified and brought to its attention would be more effective in carrying out the purpose for which the action is proposed, would be as effective and less burdensome to affected private persons that the proposed action, or would be more cost-effective to affected private persons and equally effective in implementing the statutory policy or other provision of law.

No other alternatives have been proposed or otherwise brought to the attention of CALPIA or Prison Industry Board.
